What you will need

Capture (Rip) the CD content

1 Login to the computer with your Library Card or Guest Pass

2 Push the button on the computers' DVD Drive, clip-in your home CD, push the tray closed

3 Your CD will auto play, close the VLC player software



Note: The software has created wma files which are large and <u>may not play on tablets and</u> <u>smartphones</u>. You may want to convert them to smaller mp3 files before copying them to a USB Memory Stick. Instructions for wma to mp3 Conversion are on the last page.

2 Double-click on the Music folder, Double-click on any additional folders to see your music files

3 Hold the Ctrl key and click on the files you want to copy (highlight them). Release the Ctrl key.
