Call for Entries

Artists based in the Tri-Cities, including Coquitlam, Port Moody, Port Coquitlam, and Belcarra, are invited to submit two-dimensional works in the mediums of paintings, drawings, photographs, collage, and prints.

There are two age categories: Youth (13 – 18) and Adult (19+).

Selected works will be displayed at the City Centre branch from Saturday, Oct. 4 – Sunday, Nov. 16, 2025.

Theme

Metamorphosis.

Artists are invited to submit works that explore the concept of metamorphosis: change, renewal, or transformation.

Inclusion and Diversity Statement

We acknowledge with gratitude and respect that the name Coquitlam was derived from the hə́nqəmíṇə́m (Hunquminum) word kʷikʷə́ləm (Kwikwetlem) meaning “Red Fish Up the River”. The Coquitlam Public Library is honoured to be located on the kʷikʷə́ləm traditional and ancestral lands, including those parts that were historically shared with the q̓íçəy̓ (Katzie), and other Coast Salish Peoples.

We value the diversity that exists within our community and welcome applications from Indigenous artists, people of colour, LGBTQ2S+ individuals, people with disabilities, and individuals of all socioeconomic backgrounds. Works by Indigenous artists may be prioritized.

Rules for Entries

- Two-dimensional works only - including, but not limited to, paintings, drawings, photographs, collages, and prints.
- Must be original artwork created within the last two years (2023 – 2025), that have not been submitted to the Juried Art Exhibit before.
- AI-generated artworks will not be considered for the Exhibit.
- Works must be dry, securely wired, and framed. Exceptions may be made for works that don't require frames, e.g. works with finished-edge canvases or wood cradles.
- Works must be no larger than 24 inches wide x 30 inches high and less than 20 lbs.
 - *A limited number of larger works may be accepted, depending on available display space.*
- Artists may submit up to two works for consideration.
- All accepted works must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit.
- Artists must sign a Photo Release Form allowing Coquitlam Public Library to take and use photos of them and/or their artwork.

Important Deadlines

Applications must be received in full by **Sunday, Jun. 8 at 11:59 pm**.

Successful applicants will be notified by **Tuesday, Sept. 16, and a list of successful applicants will be published on coqlibrary.ca.**

Accepted works must be received by the Library by **Saturday, Sept. 27 at 4:00 pm** for installation.

An opening reception will be held in October. The exact date is to be determined. Check coqlibrary.ca for updates.

Works will be available for pick-up after the conclusion of the exhibit, beginning **Thursday, Nov. 20**. Library staff will coordinate individual pick-up times with each artist.

Display Period and Exhibition Installation

The Juried Art Exhibition will be held at Coquitlam Public Library's City Centre branch, 1169 Pinetree Way.

Successful artists must bring their accepted works to the Library for installation on Sept. 25, 26, or 27. Library staff will coordinate drop-off times with artists. Works should be dry, framed, and securely wired or otherwise able to hang on a hook (see *Rules for Entries*).

How We Will Support Your Work

Selected works will be securely displayed in the City Centre branch of Coquitlam Public Library, giving artists a unique opportunity to showcase their work to the Tri-Cities community. In addition, we will recognize artists by:

- Highlighting three to five works that stood out to the jury
- Providing certificates to artists

An opening reception will be held in October at the City Centre branch. More information will be released on coqlibrary.ca.

Jurors

A panel of three jurors will review the applications for inclusion in the Juried Art Exhibition. The panel will include:

- One staff member from the Art Gallery at Evergreen
- One member of the Coquitlam Public Library Community Advisory Group
- One staff member from Place des Arts
